Applications for Financial Assistance are open until April 5, 2019.

Application and Selection Process (Outside the National Capital Region)

Youth and young adults up to the age of 30 years old from outside of the National Capital Region who are in financially difficult situations and could in no other ways attend the National Christian Youth Summit are invited to submit their applications for financial assistance.

Individuals in need of financial assistance must submit an application containing a CV and a letter of motivation (max. 1 page). Your motivation letter should state:

1. Your personal efforts in finding funding to attend the National Christian Youth Summit. Only those who can demonstrate they have made significant personal fundraising efforts will be selected.
 - a. We encourage you to ask family, friends or those in your church community to support you in coming. If you would like ideas on how to fundraise, please don't hesitate to contact us at the email below.
2. Your interest for attending the Summit, and how you would benefit from attending.
3. Be creative, share your heart and vision for your local church, the body of Christ and our nation.

Please note that there are only 13 subsidies, that will be distributed one per province/territory. Please send your CV and the motivation letter no later than **April 5, 2019**, by email to cathay.wagantall.a3@parl.gc.ca with the Subject line: National Christian Youth Summit.

Applications will be evaluated from March 20th, 2019 onwards and applicants will be notified on admission until April 5, 2019. **Financial Assistance will be given in the form of a cheque upon arrival in Ottawa.**

The National Christian Youth Summit will provide a subsidy to all the selected participants to cover their travel. Please note that all selected participants will have to have paid the \$170 admission fee to the National Christian Youth Summit which covers all meals and activities during the summit.
