

2019 FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q.1 What is the National Christian Youth Summit?

The National Christian Youth Summit is an opportunity for young people aged 15-35 from across Canada to come to Ottawa to meet with those who serve in and around Parliament Hill. This includes Members of Parliament, public servants, ministry and community leaders.

It is our hope that students come away from the Summit knowing the importance of walking authentically and boldly with Jesus; that as they do they participate in God's work of transforming hearts fulfilling His purposes in churches, schools, communities, governments and the nation.

Q.2 I don't have a particular interest in politics. Why should I attend?

Though some have gone on to serve in Parliamentary offices or in branches of government, many have found it helpful to attend in order to learn how to pray for those in authority (1 Timothy 2:1-2). Whether you are in high school or a university student studying a field unrelated to politics, it is important to understand the issues being debated in Parliament and how the body of Christ plays a unique role in carrying out God's kingdom purposes. You will also meet like-minded peers who are passionate about living out their faith and impacting our nation.
